


Submitting Files for Printing

Our facility uses the highest quality equipment to digitize artwork to create stunning fine art reproductions on paper or canvas. We photograph original artwork using a 102 MPX Medium format camera to insure that every brush stroke of oil, acrylic, watercolor delicate washes or all the details of pencil, charcoal and other media are brought front and center with gorgeous color matches. Sometimes it's difficult. Lighting plays a key role in assuring all of that detail is captured without specular highlights, glare, and other lighting issues that can contribute to a poor print.

In the event that you choose to photograph your own artwork that's totally fine. Just be aware that a poor quality file = a poor quality print.

File Submission

- Adobe RGB 1998 Color Space
 - Tiff or Jpeg file format
 - Submit file at the final size you want printed at 300 PPI.
 - (For example: if you want an 8x10 print, then submit your file at 8x10 at 300 ppi. If you want a 24x30 print, then submit your file at 24x30 at 300 ppi.) If you have any problem with this concept, we can certainly help you with that. If your submitted file requires a few approved modifications, we are happy to make the necessary changes for a great print. If your submitted file requires a great deal of modifications we will need to discuss.
